

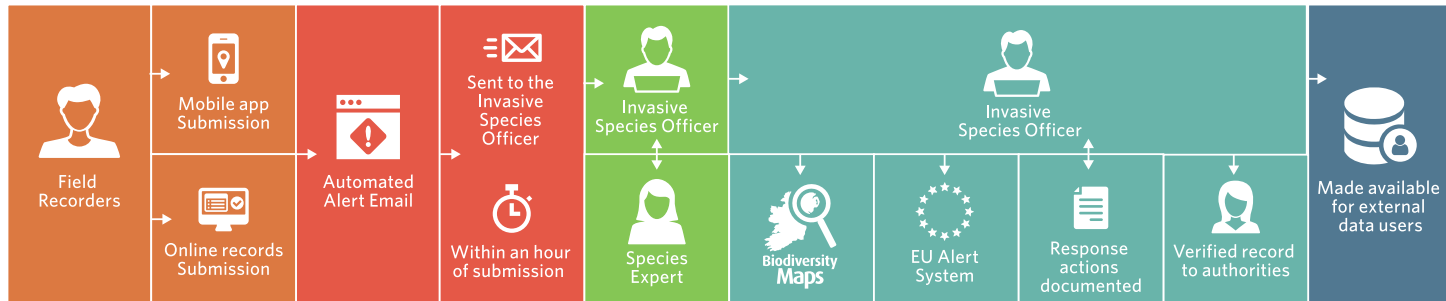
# Invasive Species Record Alert System

## A Sighting

1 Sighting is recorded.

2 Sighting record is submitted through Biodiversity Data Capture App or the online recording form.

3 An automated e-mail alert is sent to the Invasive Species Officer within an hour of submission with the full record details.

4 The Invasive Species Officer reviews the record and works to have it validated and verified. This may involve liaison with the recorder and a species expert.

5 Verified (or highly likely to be credible) records are sent to the relevant authorities.

6 The Authorities trigger on-site verification or rapid response where necessary.

7 Response actions are documented.

Authorities trigger response where necessary

8 Verified records are made available for external data users. Where relevant, the Invasive Species Officer submits the detection and rapid response actions to the European Alien Species Notification System.
